**Booth size is 17D x 9W (i.e. a parking space). One space = one booth. Prices are per space. (The space size indicated is the actual measurement of a parking space in the lot.) Vendors may assume that each space they will be renting will be the equivalent of a 10D x 10W space (2 spaces = 10D x 20W, etc.). Check-in time will be from 6AM until 7:45AM the morning of the festival. All vehicles must be out of the lot(s) by 7:45AM. Access to the lot(s) will be closed at 7:45AM - NO EXCEPTIONS!! Vendors may open at 8:30AM and will shut down no later than 5PM.**

**\*\*NO STREET VENDORS OR CARTS WILL BE PERMITTED AT THE 2011 MIDDLE TENNESSEE STRAWBERRY FESTIVAL. VIOLATORS WILL BE REMOVED.\*\***
